

Health Camp by Jodhpur School of Public Health and Mehrangarh Museum Trust



Jodhpur, Dec 2, 2018 (Issuewire.com) - With the aim of spreading Public Awareness of defeating Diabetes through training Healthcare Professionals, Screening, and Education a health camp was organized at Mehrangarh Fort, Jodhpur (Rajasthan) on 30th November 2018.
