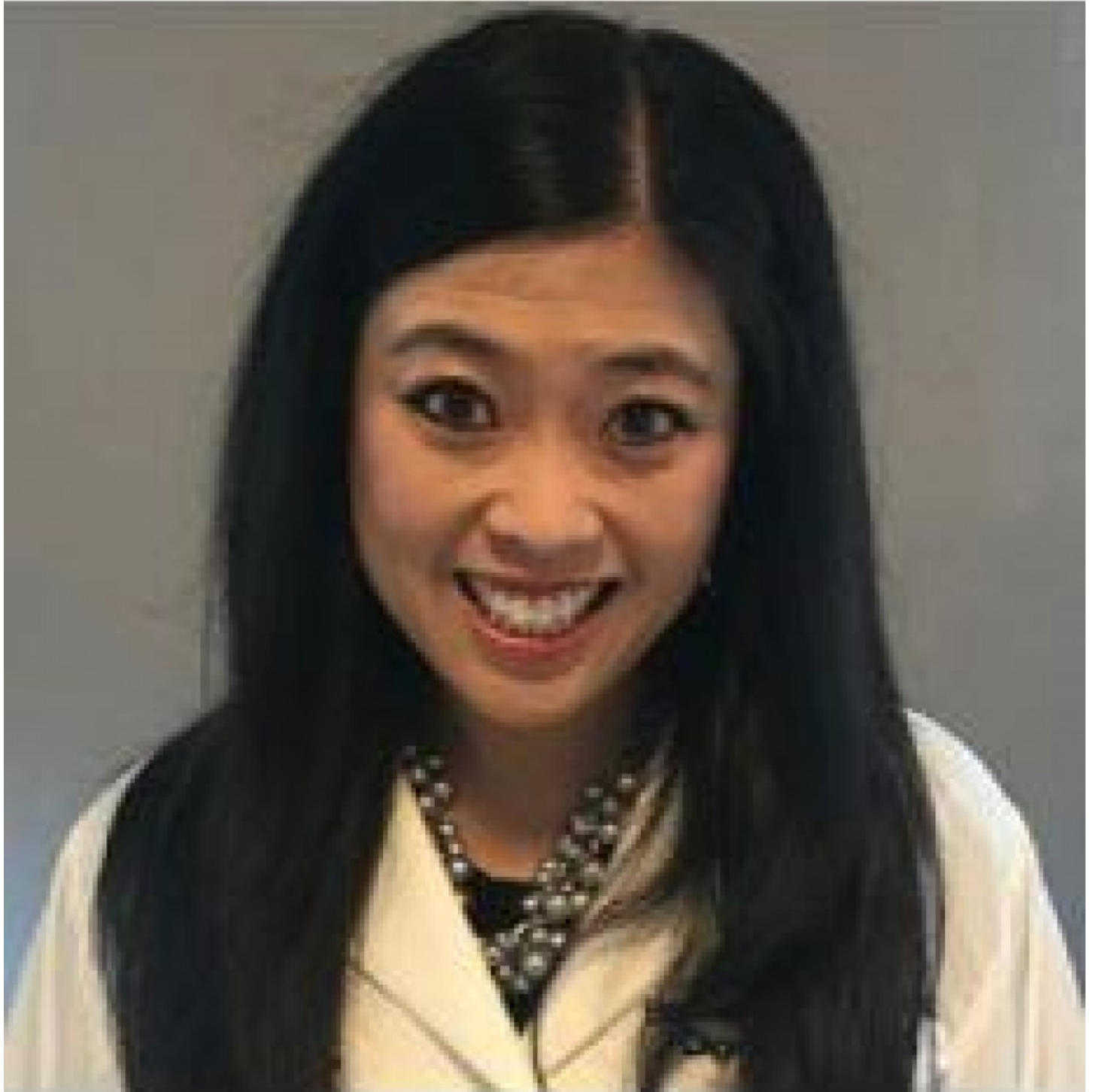


Gastroenterologist Brooke R. Glessing, MD Provides Services for the Northeast Ohio Area
