- ✓ Never respond to an email or click on a link from a person or company you don't know.



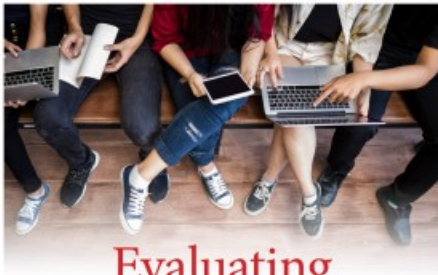

### DATE

When was the information published?  
When was the webpage last updated?  
Is the information too old to still be relevant?



### PURPOSE

Why is the information being published?  
Is it published by a company or an organization?  
What does the author or publisher have to gain by sharing the information?

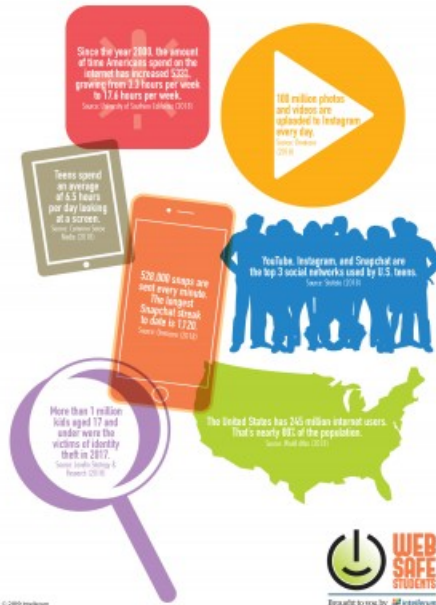


Can you verify the facts using other websites or resources?  
Did the author or publisher cite their sources?  
Are the sources they cited trustworthy?
