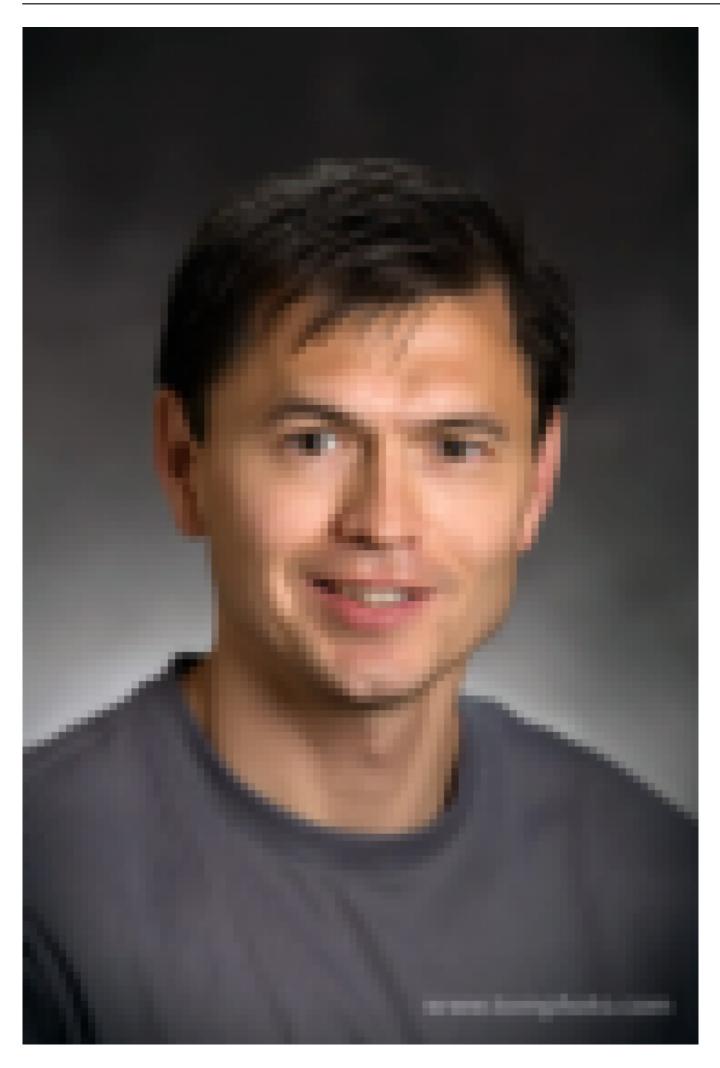
Orthopedic Surgeon Trinity Pilkington, MD Provides Services in Mid and Southern Delaware Areas

They also treat patients for sports injuries, back pain, ruptured discs, spinal stenosis, bone tumors, carpal tunnel, hand arthritis and hand injuries, club foot, bow legs, hip dysplasia, orthopedic trauma, limb lengthening, Achilles tendon injuries, bunions, foot and ankle injuries, osteoporosis, and arthritis.Dr. Pilkington focuses on arthritic conditions using less invasive surgical techniques for knee and hip replacements. In addition, his special interest in performing the anterior hip replacement which is a muscle sparing technique allowing quicker recovery and less pain after hip replacement surgery
