

BOLD Awards Announce Five Nominees in Each of Twelve Categories

New York City, Mar 6, 2019 (IssueWire.com) - Online voting has now ended and we are delighted to share the names of the final five nominees in each of the 12 categories of the first annual [BOLD Awards](#) for outstanding crowdsourcing project, launched by [Crowdsourcing Week](#) team.
