

## EC-Council announces its first CISO Forum in Canada

EC-Council's CISO events are closed-door events gathering the highest-level executives from across industries and countries to discuss the most pressing issues in information security. talks, panel discussions, and an incident response exercise that will help CISOs get a 360-degree understanding of what happens during a breach and how they should prepare. An excursion to an area winery or golf course is also planned with more details to come.
