I began to recognize there is a real need out there. People are seeking ways to express what they are feeling and their ideas, in hopes of building authentic connections and improve relationships, but they're just not sure what to say sometimes or the best way to say it to achieve the desired outcomes."

The Text Book addresses those issues and covers other topics such as texting etiquette, avoiding texting pitfalls, improving the subtext of your texts, and texting basics like how to know if a text was read, etc.

Also included are hundreds of ready-to-send text messages like the "100 ways to say hello" chapter, and a Texting Quiz to help people discover their own texting personality, characteristics, and traits.

"Knowing your starting point and own texting personality can go a long way in understanding how to communicate better with others. I think people like self-discovery."

Upon determining your texting personality, there are tips and information to help each personality type communicate better with others. Rossi developed the Texting Personalities after studying Hippocrates' Four Temperaments which originated in ancient Greece, around 400 B.C.
