
Rufus W. Gore, MD, an Orthopedic Surgeon with Rancho Orthopedics - Conformis

Dr Gore earned his medical degree from Georgetown University School of Medicine in Washington D.C. He served his internship at the National Naval Medical Center and his residency at the Naval Hospital - both of which are located in Bethesda, Maryland. Following his residency, he spent 12 years in the U.S. Navy holding key positions such as Department Head of the U.S. Naval Hospital in Naples, Italy and Head of Orthopedic Surgery at the U.S. Naval Hospital in Long Beach, California.

Dr Gore has held several faculty appointments, including Program Director and Director of Orthopedics Training at the U.S. Naval Hospital in Long Beach, as well as Clinical Instructor of Surgery at The Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences F. Edward Hébert School of Medicine. He has also held several medical staff leadership positions, including Chief of Surgery and Chief of Staff.

Dr Gore is a Fellow of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons. He is also a member of the American Medical Association, the California Medical Association, the California Orthopaedic Association, the Society of Military Orthopaedic Surgeons, and the Riverside County Medical Association.

Dr Gore is board-certified in orthopaedic surgery by the American Board of Orthopaedic Surgery (ABOS). Founded in 1934 as a private, voluntary, nonprofit, autonomous organization, the ABOS exists to serve the best interest of the public and the medical profession by establishing educational standards for orthopaedic residents and by evaluating the initial and continuing qualifications and competence of orthopaedic surgeons.

Orthopaedic surgery or orthopaedics is the branch of surgery that deals with conditions involving the musculoskeletal system. An orthopaedic surgeon offers care to patients suffering from problems associated with the joints, bones, muscles, tendons, and ligaments. They perform surgeries to address trauma, injuries, tumours, infections, and other conditions that require surgical intervention. "Orthopedics is great medicine. It is very satisfying to work. I like the challenge of the mechanics' aspect, but the best is helping people" as stated by Dr Gore.
