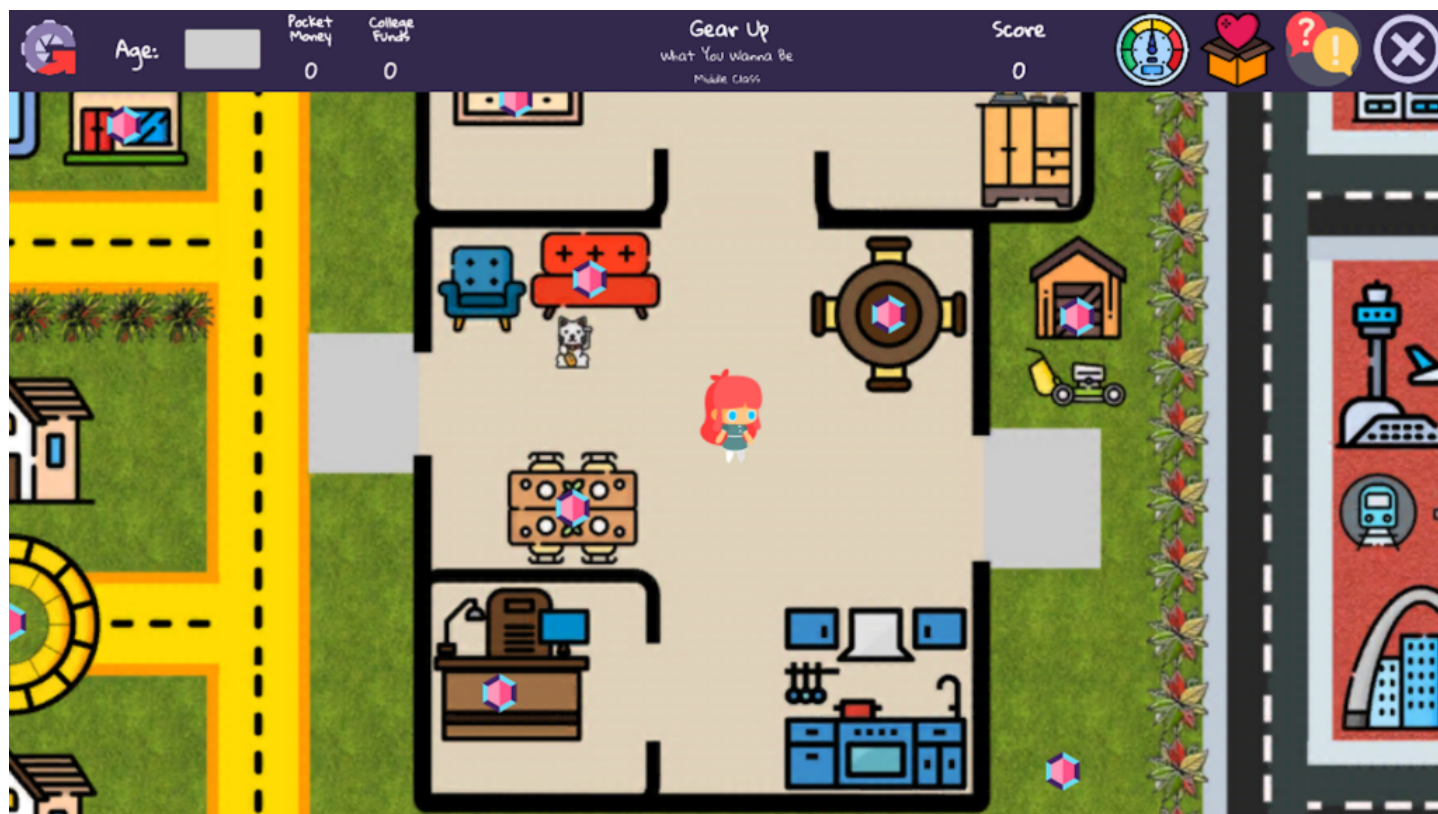


GEAR UP role-playing game to prepare high school students for college admission and alternate career
