Other RN job functions include performing diagnostic tests and analyzing results, operating medical equipment, administering medications, recording patients' symptoms and medical histories, and assisting with patient rehabilitation and follow-up.

Certified nurse, operating room (CNOR) certification is the documented validation of the professional achievement of identified standards of practice by an individual registered nurse providing care for patients before, during, and after surgery. CNOR means that a nurse has demonstrated the knowledge and skills that denote competency in the specialized field of perioperative nursing.
