Thereafter, he completed his fellowship in critical care at Massachusetts General Hospital in Boston.

In addition to being a Fellow of the American Society of Anesthesiologists, Dr. Moayed is board certified in both anesthesiology and critical care medicine by the American Board of Anesthesiology (ABA). As the certifying body for anesthesiologists since 1938, the mission of the ABA is to advance the highest standards of the practice of anesthesiology.

Anesthesiology is the medical specialty concerned with the total perioperative care of patients before, during, and after surgery. It encompasses anesthesia, intensive care medicine, critical emergency medicine, and pain medicine. Anesthesiologists, like Dr. Moayed, have the primary responsibility of monitoring the patient's vital signs during surgery.
