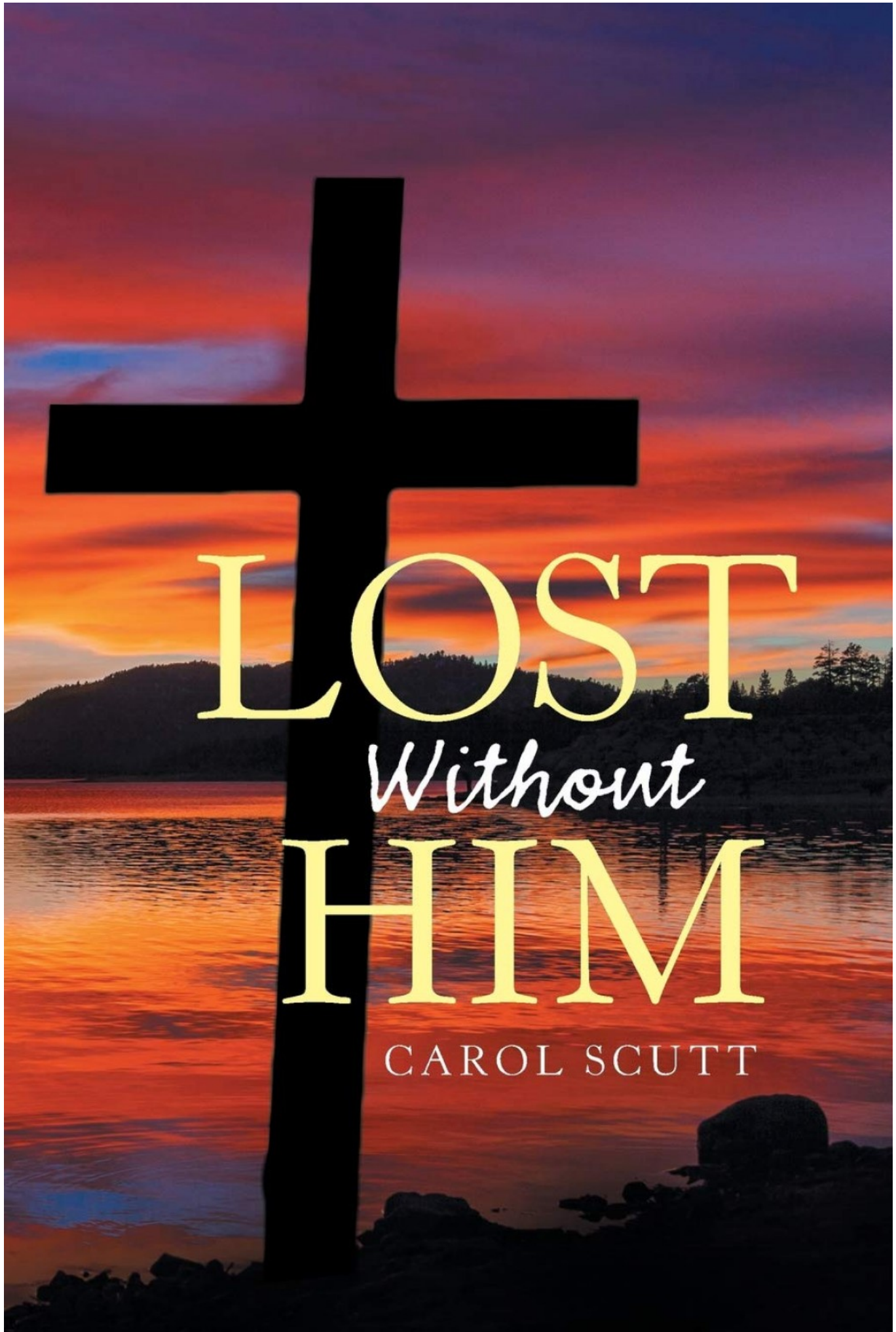

Paul was drafted and sent to Vietnam for fourteen months. Years later, their marriage encountered a trial strong enough that they nearly divorced. But they were able to overcome the hurt and heartache, and the readers will find their story as an inspiring lesson. Their love for each other and for Christ drew them together during all the difficult times
