In addition to basic measurements such as pulse, blood pressure and temperature, anesthesiologists also measure the patient's respiration.

Pain medicine is a medical specialty that focuses on the evaluation, treatment, and prevention of pain. A pain management specialist is a physician with special training in evaluation, diagnosis, and treatment of all different types of pain. Generally, pain management that is offered at a pain clinic includes a combination of therapies, including medications, physical therapy, and nerve blocks. In addition, massage therapy is often an effective treatment for pain relief, swelling, and stress.
