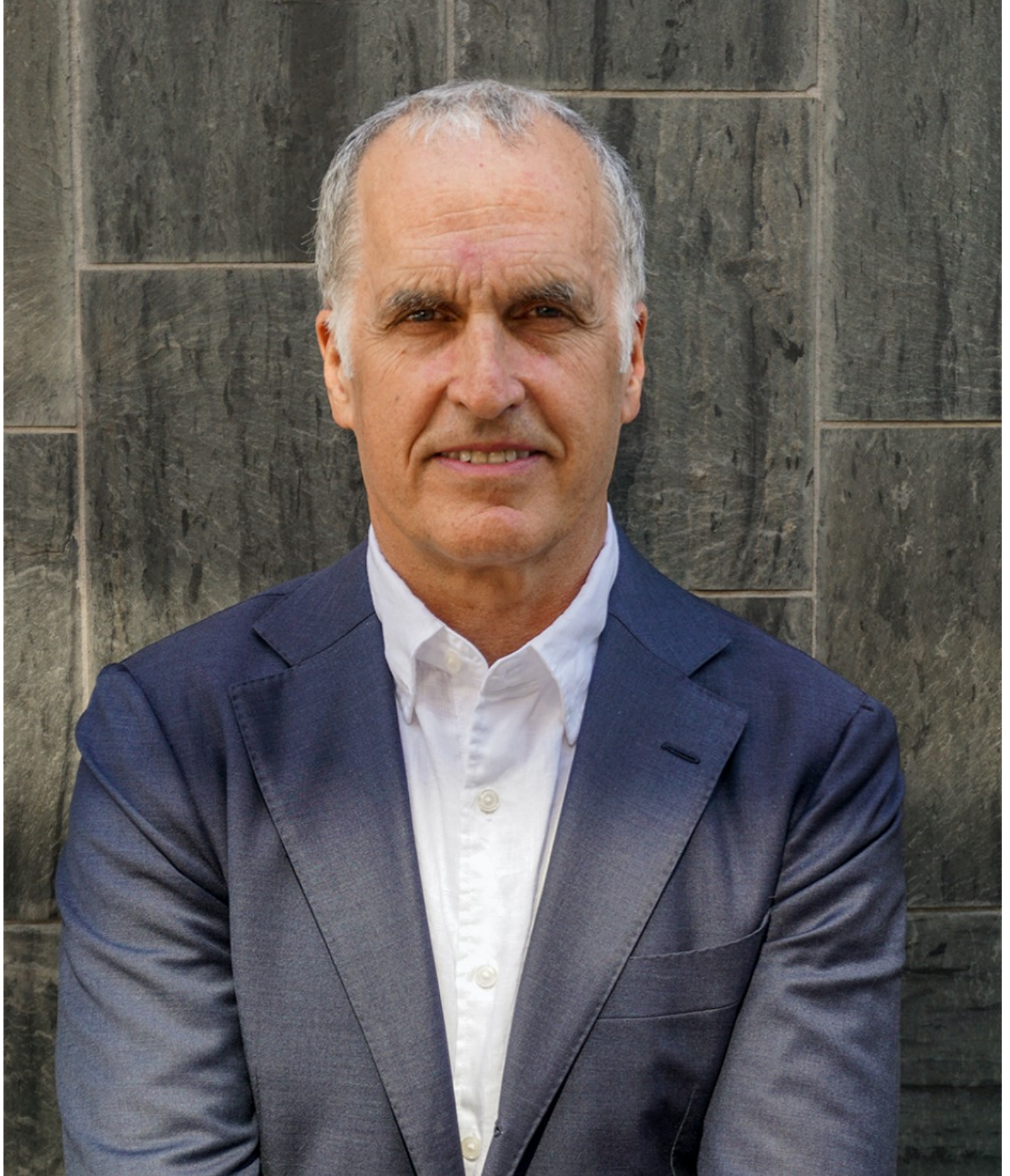


Krueck + Sexton Founding Partner Mark Sexton Elected to Illinois Institute of Technology Board of Trustees

Sexton, who earned a Bachelor of Architecture degree from IIT College of Architecture in 1980, joins a distinguished group of business and community leaders as trustees of the private, technology-focused research university.

“IIT was foundational to my own professional career—as well as the careers of so many of my K+S colleagues,” says Sexton. “I’m excited to have this opportunity to help further strengthen the university as it continues to inspire and equip students for success.”

Sexton also led the Krueck + Sexton design team overseeing the 2005 restoration of S. R. Crown Hall, a 1956 IIT College of Architecture building designed by renowned architect Mies van der Rohe and considered one of the most architecturally significant buildings of the 20th Century Modernist movement.

Sexton was formally elected by the IIT Board of Trustees during its October 2019 meeting.
