The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Clinical cardiac electrophysiology is a branch of the medical specialty of cardiology that is concerned with the study and treatment of rhythm disorders of the heart. Cardiologists with expertise in this area are usually referred to as clinical cardiac electrophysiologists. They focus on the heart's timing, or electrical system, and on diagnosing and treating irregular heartbeats or arrhythmias. They are also qualified to perform special tests and procedures on the heart and its electrical systems, such as an electrophysiology study and ablation and implant cardiac devices, such as pacemakers and defibrillators.

As such, Dr. Sichrovsky had always been fascinated by how the complex human body works and how to intervene when it doesn't work the way it should. She also likes the fact that as a doctor, she plays a very humanistic role in working to make others feel better and live longer. In addition to English, she speaks German.
