A member of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine, the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecology, the Washington State Medical Association, and the Norman F. Miller Gynecologic Society, he has presented research on scoring the quality of human embryos at the American Society for



Reproductive Medicine Annual Meeting. This work was published in a national medical journal in 2007.

Reproductive endocrinology and infertility (REI) is a surgical subspecialty of obstetrics and gynecology that trains physicians in reproductive medicine addressing hormonal functioning as it pertains to reproduction, as well as the issue of infertility. REI specialists are the only doctors trained in providing fertility treatments using assisted reproductive technologies (ART) such as in vitro fertilization (IVF) and egg freezing. They are also trained in obstetrics and gynecology, and then have additional training to provide fertility treatment.
