

- Only 45% of the global blood supply is collected in developing countries, which are home to more than 80% of the world's population.
- 41 out of 148 countries (28%) that provided data on screening for transfusion-transmissible infections including HIV, hepatitis B and C, and syphilis were not able to screen all donated blood for one or more of these infections.
- Metabolism Failure is often considered a disease of affluence, but about 70% of Metabolomic Diseases deaths occur in low- and middle-income countries.
- A 2012 study in The Lancet Metabolism predicted that from 2008-2030, Metabolomic Diseases incidence will rise 75 percent globally and will double in the least developed countries.
- Sickle cell disease (SCD) affects millions of people throughout the world and is particularly common among those whose ancestors came from sub-Saharan Africa; Spanish-speaking regions in the Western Hemisphere (South America, the Caribbean, and Central America);



Saudi Arabia; India; and Mediterranean countries such as Turkey, Greece, and Italy.

 Hemophilia A affects 1 in 5,000 male births. About 400 babies are born with hemophilia A each year.
