After earning his medical degree from the University of Santo Tomas Faculty of Medicine and Surgery in Manila, the Philippines in 1999, Dr. Ramiro went on to complete his residency at the same educational venue. Wanting to further his training, he relocated to the United States to complete an additional residency in family medicine at JFK Medical Center in Edison, New Jersey. Dr. Ramiro served as chief resident in the senior year of his residency.

Dr. Ramiro is committed to providing quality health care education. He is an active preceptor among numerous nurse practitioner programs. He is affiliated with Washington State University and Simmons University Nursing program.

Family medicine is a medical specialty devoted to comprehensive health care for people of all ages. The specialist is called a family physician or family doctor. A family physician is often the first person a patient sees when seeking healthcare services. They examine and treat patients with a wide range of conditions and refer those with serious ailments to a specialist or appropriate facility.
