The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

An electrophysiologist is a type of cardiologist. They focus on the heart's timing, or electrical system, and on diagnosing and treating irregular heartbeats or arrhythmias. They are also qualified to perform special tests of the heart's electrical system, such as an electrophysiology study or an ablation.
