Among his professional affiliations, he is a member of the Allegheny County Medical Society, the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons, the American Medical Association, the Interstate Orthopaedic Society, the Pennsylvania Medical Society, and the Pennsylvania Orthopaedic Society. He has also published and presented extensively on orthopaedic surgery topics.
