

## SplashLearn Announces Winners of SpringBoard Math Challenge 2020

Mega success with participation from over 450K students

Along with national winners, 50 State Leaderboard winners also

won prizes, based on their best of 6 weeks score. The students who participated and achieved their weekly target at least once during the 10-week duration would receive a 'Certificate of Participation'.

**Ms. Erin Noel, the teacher of the winning class** (1st Grade Bluejays, Petersburg Elementary School, Illinois) said "The Springboard competition has always been a great motivator for my students! My students were so excited to learn we got 1st place in the competition! I am so very proud of their hard work over the 10 weeks.
