
## For the Chosen Few 2020 - POSTPONED



With the innovative water wheel, women and girls in rural villages can transport 5 times more water between faraway wells and their homes without enduring the physical strain of carrying water buckets on their heads. Making water more easily gatherable allows girls who would otherwise be tasked with getting water for their families to attend school.

The coronavirus pandemic necessitated the For the Chosen Few postponement, but it did nothing to undermine or alleviate the plight faced by rural Indian communities. Water is more important now than ever for taking extra hygienic precautions to minimise the spread of the novel virus. In addition to delivering water wheels, Wells on Wheels has committed to distributing thousands of facemasks among some of the Indian villages that have been hit hardest by the pandemic.

After the 2019 For the Chosen Few event, a guest remarked, "I have never seen anything like this in dentistry, or anywhere else for that matter." It's likely that the 2021 event, with more attendees and public recognition than before, will again surpass our expectations
