called 'Grand Gang Management' with futuristic facilities. He is on a musical spree as his 10th musical album gets completed.

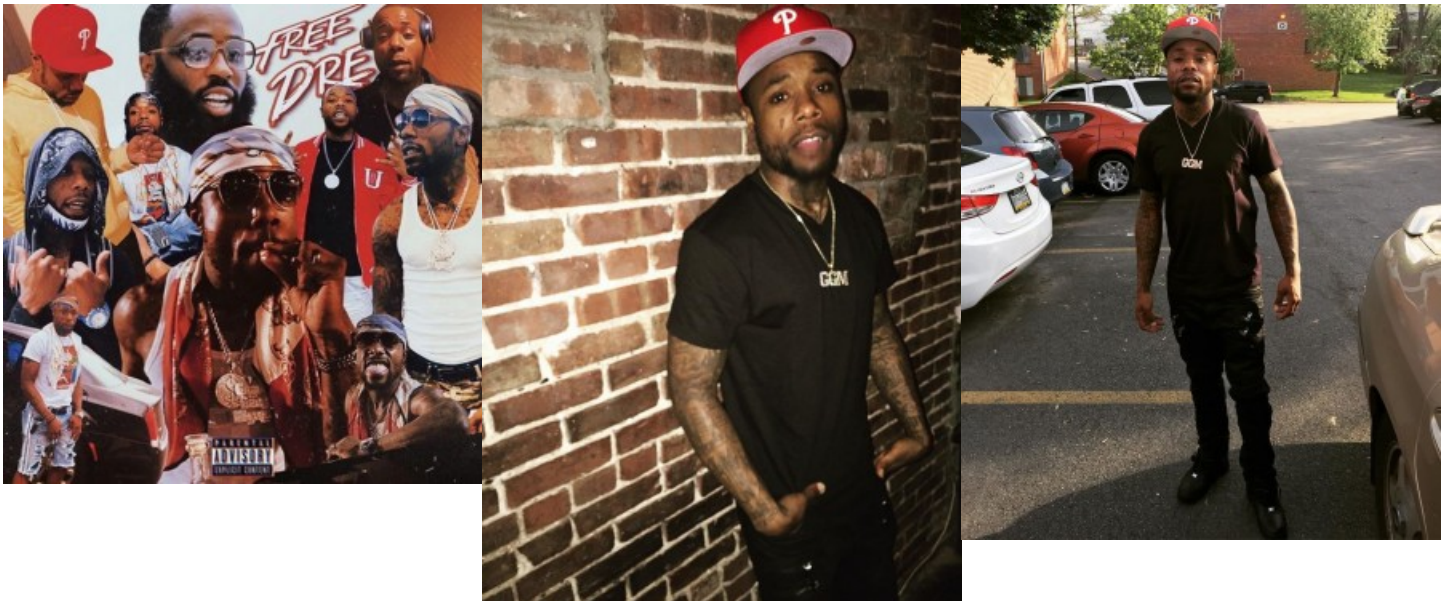
