A Fellow of the American College of Cardiology (FACC), the doctor is board-certified in cardiovascular disease and clinical cardiac electrophysiology by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Cardiology is a branch of medicine that deals with the disorders of the heart, as well as the circulatory system. The field includes medical diagnosis and treatment of congenital heart defects, coronary artery disease, heart failure, valvular heart disease, and electrophysiology. Cardiologists are doctors who diagnose, assess, and treat patients with diseases and defects of the heart and blood vessels (the cardiovascular system).

Cardiac electrophysiology is the science of elucidating, diagnosing, and treating the electrical activities of the heart. A clinical cardiac electrophysiologist, or cardiac EP, is a healthcare provider who treats heart rhythm problems. A cardiac EP is a type of cardiologist.

An expert in his field, Dr. Choucair has contributed to a number of publications, including the Journal of the American Heart Association, The American Journal of Cardiology, and Washington University School of Medicine. He has also been honored with several awards and recognitions, including Compassionate Doctor Recognition (2014, 2015, 2016), Patients' Choice Award (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017), and On-Time Doctor Award (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017).
