Both not-for-profit organizations oversee the certification and ongoing professional development of specialists in their respected fields.

In addition to being a Fellow of the American College of Radiation Oncology (FACRO), Dr. Kahn is a member of the American Society for Therapeutic Radiation and Oncology, the American College of Radiology, the Florida Radiological Society, the Florida Medical Association, and the Hillsborough County Medical Association.

The doctor's affiliations include Brandon Hospital, South Bay Hospital, Town & Country Hospital, South Florida Baptist Hospital, Tampa General Hospital, and Memorial Hospital. He is also associated with the Brandon CyberKnife Center and the CyberKnife Center of Tampa.

It is one of the three primary specialties, the other two being surgical and medical oncology, involved in the treatment of cancer. A radiation oncologist is a specialist physician who uses ionizing radiation in the treatment of cancer.
