Professionally, Dr. Ambler has made numerous presentations at conferences across the country and has written multiple publications on postoperative adhesion development, endometriosis, ectopic pregnancies, and uterine anomalies. Among her extensive research topics, her fellowship focused on genetics, utilizing microarray technology, to characterize postoperative adhesion development. This research has awarded her several honors, including nominee for the prize paper, at the American Society of Reproductive Medicine.
