

Handcrafted Exotic Wood Trays by Noted Woodworker Now Available



San Diego, Nov 9, 2020 (<u>Issuewire.com</u>) - Handcrafted, stunningly beautiful exotic wood trays by noted San Diego woodworker Larry Sherman are now available just in time for the holidays.

Using exotic woods from around the world, such as Wenge, Ebony, Eucalyptus and Rosewood, Sherman has designed a limited number of these trays. The design incorporates bentwood arms made from three pieces of lumber laminated together to form convex sides and either convex or concave ends. Arms vary from clear finished hardwoods to stained woods. Bases on the bottom side range from natural hardwood to black painted Poplar to ebony stained Douglas Fir. All trays are finished with three coats of lacquer. Every tray is different and averaged about 15 hours of labor to produce.

Measuring 3 inches x 13 inches x 20 inches, each tray is designed with a scooped-out base to sit easily in your lap, and each also rests on flat surfaces for display or any use!

Sure to be a collector's item, each tray is numbered, signed and dated.
