
## **Shane Hennessy, DO, a Sports Medicine Specialist with The Orthopedic Group**

In addition, he provided medical care to the PGA Tour; the Virginia Tech, Duquesne University Pittsburgh Central Catholic football teams; the Pittsburgh Marathon and EQT Ten-Mile Race; and the University of Pittsburgh swimming and diving teams.

Playing an active role in his field, Dr. Hennessey is board-certified in family medicine and sports medicine by the American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM). The ABFM is a non-profit, independent medical association of American physicians who practice in family medicine and its sub-specialties.

Sports medicine is a branch of medicine that deals with physical fitness and the treatment and prevention of injuries related to sports and exercise. A sports medicine specialist is a physician with significant specialized training in both the treatment and prevention of illness and injury.

Among his most notable achievements, Dr. Hennessy received the "Exceptional Resident Teacher" Award from UPMC Shadyside Family Medicine, and the "Exceptional Resident Teacher" and "Exceptional Role Model" awards from Family and Community Medicine at Penn State College of Medicine.
