
George J. Palmer, MD, FACS, a Cardiothoracic Surgeon with Cardiovascular Surgeons, P.A.

A native of New Orleans, Dr. Palmer graduated with his medical degree from the Creighton University School of Medicine. He completed his surgical internship and residency at the University of Alabama at Birmingham Hospital, capping his tenure there as Chief Resident. He next served as a resident in cardiothoracic transplant and as a cardiothoracic Research Fellow at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, continuing there as a resident in thoracic surgery and finally as chief resident of cardiothoracic surgery.

Dedicated to clinical excellence, the doctor is board-certified in thoracic and cardiac surgery by the American Board of Thoracic Surgery (ABTS). The ABTS is an American surgical organization devoted to surgery of the chest.

Furthermore, he is board-certified in surgery by the American Board of Surgery, an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.

Cardiothoracic surgery is the field of medicine involved in the surgical treatment of organs inside the thorax. Cardiothoracic surgeons are medical doctors who specialize in surgical procedures inside the thorax, which may involve the heart, lungs, esophagus, and other organs in the chest. Alongside performing surgery, they also diagnose and treat diseases of these organs.
