Following an appointment as Virginia's Secretary of Commerce and Trade by Governor Terry McAuliffe, Mr. Jones became President and CEO of the Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC), a national community development financial institution and nonprofit with initiatives in 35 cities and 2100 rural

counties in 44 states. Effective March 1, 2021, Mr. Jones will be CEO of OneTen, a coalition of leaders to upskill, hire, and create opportunities for Black Americans.

Mr. Jones said, "Solutions to the world's biggest problems can come from anyone, anywhere. Nonetheless, women, people of color, and entrepreneurs in rural areas are largely overlooked by the venture capital community. Ignite Social Impact is a tremendous opportunity to illuminate underserved innovators and empower them to address the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals for a better future."

Rosemarie Truman, Co-Founder, and CEO of Ignite declared, "Every year, about 60,000 tech startups are created, but less than 2% of them get funding, or 1,200. Of the 1,200 funded, 12 (1%) of them are co-founded by Black entrepreneurs, and 36 (3%) of them are co-founded by women. With guidance from Maurice Jones, Ignite will be better prepared to close racial and gender gaps in wealth potential with crowdfunding to connect great talent with opportunity."
