Boyar specializes in neonatal-perinatal medicine, pediatrics, and wound care. She is the Interim Medical Director of the Neonatal-Perinatal Unit & the Director of Neonatal Skin and Wound Services at Steven and Alexandra Cohen Children's Medical Center at Long Island Jewish Medical Center.

Collaborating with Northwell Health, Dr. Boyar is affiliated with Huntington Hospital, Long Island Jewish Forest Hills, Long Island Jewish Medical Center, North Shore University Hospital, and South Shore University Hospital.

Alongside her clinical role, she serves as an Assistant Professor at the Donald and Barbara Zucker School of Medicine at Hofstra/Northwell.

Graduating with her medical degree from the University of North Carolina School of Medicine in 2002, Dr. Boyar went on to perform her residency in pediatrics at North Shore University Hospital in 2005. This was followed by a fellowship in neonatal-perinatal medicine at Steven and Alexandra Cohen Children's Medical Center at Long Island Jewish Medical Center in 2008.

Dedicated to excellence, the doctor is board-certified in neonatal-perinatal medicine and pediatrics by the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP). The ABP exists to promote excellence in medical care for children and adolescents. Certification represents dedication by pediatricians, pediatric subspecialists, and pediatric trainees to the highest level of professionalism in patient care.

Holding a standard of excellence in multidisciplinary wound certification, Dr. Boyar is board-certified through the American Board of Wound Management.

Continuously advancing her efforts, she is an active member of the Society of Pediatric Research, the American Academy of Pediatrics, the International Society of Pediatric Wound Care, and the Association for the Advancement of Wound Care.

Neonatology is a subspecialty of pediatrics that consists of the medical care of newborn infants, especially the ill, or premature newborn. It is a hospital-based specialty and is practiced in neonatal intensive care units. Neonatologists generally diagnose and treat newborns with conditions such as breathing disorders, infections, and birth defects, as well as coordinating care and medically managing newborns born prematurely, critically ill, or in need of surgery.
