


## Kim Kjome, MD, a Psychiatrist with Ascension Seton Shoal Creek

They have also been faculty at UT McGovern, UTMB, Texas A&M, and UT-Southwestern Medical Schools.

"Since I was little, I have wanted to be a doctor. I think it is especially hard to have an illness that society sometimes doesn't understand. Mental health conditions are a challenge for the people who experience them, and I appreciate working with them as they recover" as stated by Dr. Kjome.

Passionate about their profession, they are board-certified in psychiatry by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology (ABPN). The ABPN is a not-for-profit corporation dedicated to serving the professions of psychiatry and neurology.

Among their professional affiliations, she is a member of the American Psychiatric Association, the Texas Medical Association, and the Travis County Medical Society.

Psychiatry is the medical specialty devoted to the diagnosis, prevention, and treatment of mental disorders. These include various maladaptations related to mood, behavior, cognition, and perceptions. Psychiatrists evaluate, diagnose, and treat patients with mental, emotional, and behavioral disorders. They conduct thorough psychiatric evaluations, develop treatment plans, prescribe medication, and evaluate treatment results.

In many aspects of medical education, Dr. Kjome has been involved in mood, impulsivity, and addiction research.
