The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

Named a Top Doctor in Bergen Magazine (2018, 2019), Dr. Diamond has published papers and delivered presentations on treatment issues related to renal cell carcinoma, prostate cancer, head and neck cancer, liver cancer, and heparin-induced thrombocytopenia, the abnormal formation of blood clots within blood vessels.

An active member of the American Society of Clinical Oncology and the Society of Urologic Oncology, he is affiliated with Holy Name Medical Center at the Patricia Lynch Cancer Center.

Genitourinary oncology focuses on research and treatment of urinary system cancers in both genders, as well as malignancies affecting the male sexual organs. Genitourinary oncologists are trained in internal medicine and oncology. They are responsible for hormonal therapy, chemotherapy, immune-based therapy, and targeted therapies.
