He attended the Bowman Gray School of Medicine at Wake Forest University followed by a residency in general surgery in Huntington, West Virginia, a fellowship in surgical critical care at Columbus Children's Hospital in Ohio, and a fellowship in pediatric surgery at Schneider Children's Hospital in New York.

Dedicated to excellence, the doctor is board-certified in general surgery, pediatric surgery, and surgical critical care by the American Board of Surgery (ABS). The ABS is an independent, non-profit organization located in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, founded for the purpose of certifying surgeons who have met a defined standard of education, training, and knowledge.
