This was followed by a residency in ophthalmology at Interfaith Medical Center in 1996 and a fellowship in cornea and external disease under the supervision of Dr. James Aquavella, a world-renowned ophthalmology specialist, at the University of Rochester in 1997.

In addition to being a Fellow of the American Academy of Ophthalmology, he is board-certified in ophthalmology by the American Board of Ophthalmology (ABO). The ABO is an independent, non-profit organization responsible for certifying ophthalmologists in the United States of America.

Licensed to practice medicine in Florida, Dr. Barish is affiliated with Delray Medical Center, JFK Medical Center - Florida, Bethesda Hospital East, and West Boca Medical Center.

Ophthalmology is a branch of medicine and surgery, which deals with the diagnosis and treatment of eye disorders. Ophthalmologists are experts in the diseases, functions, and anatomy of the eye.
