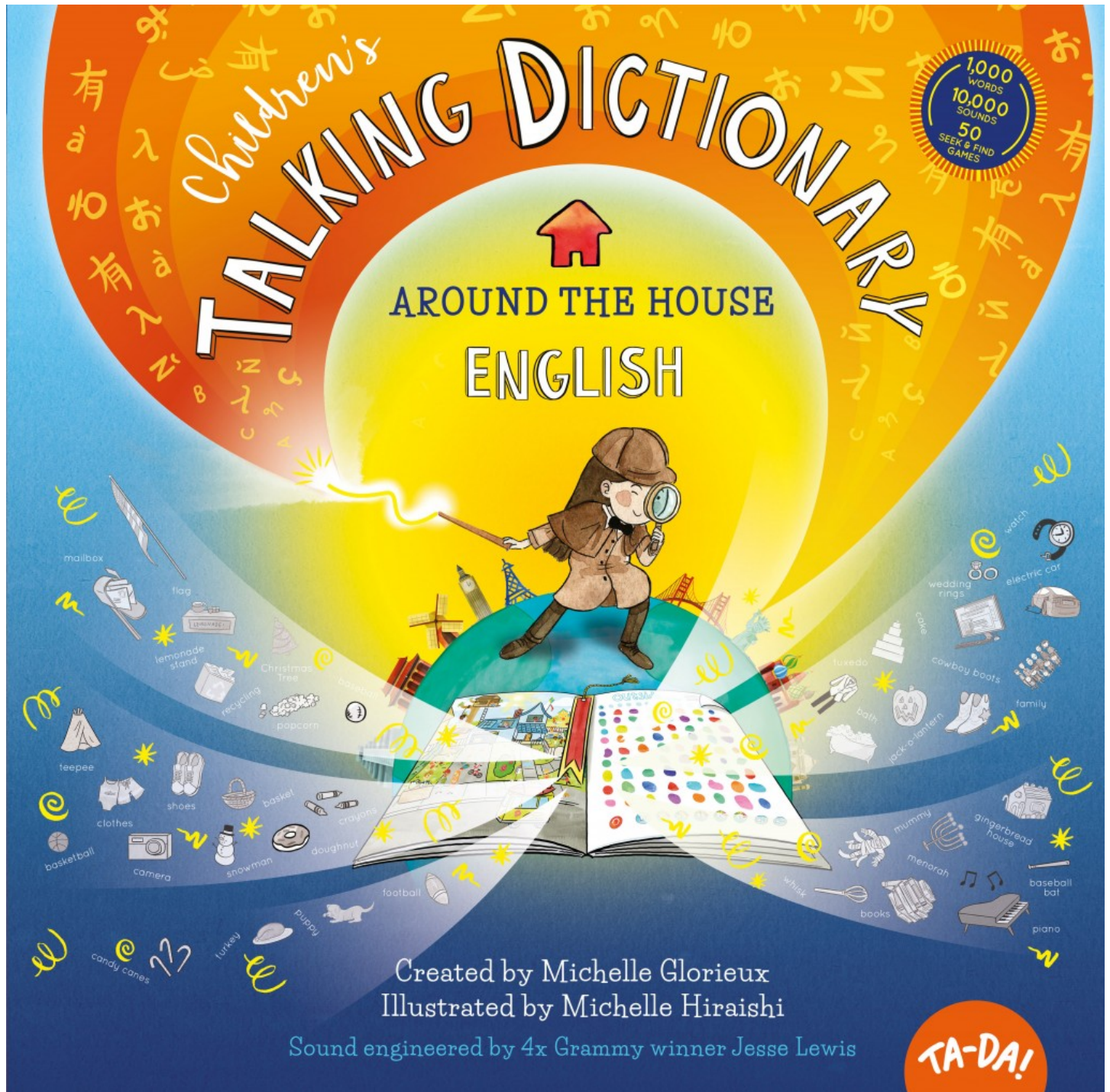


# Children's TALKING DICTIONARY by TA-DA! Language Productions
