After medical school, he completed his residency at Baylor Scott & White Medical Center, which is part of Texas A&M Health Science Center College of Medicine in Temple, Texas. He was named chief resident and received extensive training in foot and ankle injuries as well as reconstructive surgery. His training covered a wide scope of foot and ankle issues, including major limb deformity, total joint replacement, and trauma care.

Following residency, Dr. Graney elected to complete his fellowship at the Florida Orthopedic Foot & Ankle Center in Sarasota, Florida. This fellowship focused on trauma, sports medicine, total ankle replacement, as well as complex deformity correction.

An Associate of the American College of Foot and Ankle Surgery, he is a member of the American Podiatric Medical Association, the Arthroscopy Association of North America, the American Society of Podiatric Surgeons, and the American Academy of Podiatric Practice Management.

Podiatry is a branch of medicine devoted to the study, diagnosis, and medical and surgical treatment of a variety of disorders of the foot, ankle, and lower extremity. A podiatrist, also known as a podiatric physician or a foot and ankle surgeon, is a medical professional devoted to the treatment of disorders of the foot, ankle, and lower extremities. They can treat injuries and complications from ongoing health issues like diabetes.
