Among his professional affiliations, Dr. Giangobbe is a member of the Society of Laparoendoscopic Surgeons, the American Venous Forum, the Society of Gastrointestinal and Endoscopic Surgeons, the American Vein & Lymphatic Society, and the Society of Diagnostic Medical Sonographers. They follow the patient through critical care and surgical recovery all the way to outpatient care.

Vascular surgery is a surgical subspecialty in which diseases of the vascular system, including the arteries, veins, and lymphatic circulation, are managed by medical therapy, minimally-invasive catheter procedures, and surgical reconstruction. A vascular surgeon diagnoses treat, and manages conditions in the arteries and veins, also called the blood vessels. These specialists treat a range of health problems, from spider and varicose veins to life-threatening aneurysms, and can help patients manage chronic conditions throughout their lives.
