They manage and prevent common and complex diseases by providing comprehensive care and promoting overall well-being.

He is a published author of multiple research articles, including Triad of Iron Deficiency Anemia, Severe Thrombocytopenia and Menorrhagia, as well as Paget Schroetter Syndrome.
