
Candace Hrelec, MD, an Otolaryngologist with Cleveland Clinic Main Campus

Her specialty interests encompass the full range of voice and oropharyngeal swallowing disorders, including medical and surgical care of the professional/performer's voice; benign vocal cord lesions such as nodules or polyps; vocal cord dysplasia or early cancer; vocal cord papilloma; vocal cord paralysis; and neuro laryngological problems such as spasmodic dysphonia, Zenker's diverticulum, and cricopharyngeal dysphagia. She also sees adult patients with airway problems such as subglottic stenosis or bilateral vocal cord paralysis.

Licensed to practice medicine in Ohio and Florida, Dr. Hrelec is affiliated with Cleveland Clinic Weston.
