From there, Dr. Al-Ameri went on to complete a clinical fellowship in leukemia at The University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center (2009 - 2011), and a clinical residency in internal medicine at Akron General Medical Center (2011 - 2014).

A Fellow of the American College of Physicians (FACP), he is board-certified in internal medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.
