


Bob B. Shafa, MD, a Neurosurgeon with The Institute of Brain and Spine Surgery

Armed with his undergraduate degree acquired from David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA in Los Angeles, California, in 1996, Dr. Shafa completed his medical degree at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, in 2001. He then served his general surgery internship at Harbor UCLA Medical Center (2001-2002) and his neurosurgery residency at Loma Linda University School of Medicine (2002-2006). To advance his training, Dr. Shafa conducted a spine surgery fellowship at the Swedish Neuroscience Institute in Seattle, Washington (2006-2007).

Subsequent to his education, the doctor attained board certification in neurosurgery through the American Board of Neurological Surgery. The broad aim of the American Board of Neurological Surgery is to encourage the study, improve the practice, elevate the standards, and advance the science of neurological surgery, and thereby serve the cause of public health.

Neurosurgery or neurological surgery, known in common parlance as brain surgery, is the medical specialty concerned with the prevention, diagnosis, surgical treatment, and rehabilitation of disorders that affect any portion of the nervous system including the brain, spinal cord, central and peripheral nervous system, and cerebrovascular system.

Dr. Shafa maintains professional memberships with the California Association of Neurological Surgeons, the American Association of Neurological Surgeons, and the Congress of Neurological Surgeons. He has privileges at Torrance Memorial IPA in Torrance, California, and the Providence Health System.
