Dr. Lieber served as Associate Director of Critical Care in Waterbury Hospital before relocating to South Florida. He continues to mentor Physician Assistant students while in private practice.

A Chairman of the Quality Management Committee at the Westside Regional Medical Center and a Consultant for the United Sleep Lab Health System, Dr. Lieber is affiliated with Northwest Medical Center, University Hospital, and Coral Springs Medical Center.

"I was formally trained in internal medicine with specialty training in pulmonary and critical care medicine. I found, over the years, that treating critically ill patients gave me great satisfaction. However, I missed the foundation of why I went into internal medicine. I enjoy caring for patients as individuals. In some instances, I care for 3 generations of families, which is extremely fulfilling. Spending the time to completely understand my patients' needs is vitally important to creating better health and preventing setbacks in the future" expressed the doctor.

Recognized as a Fellow of the American College of Chest Physicians (FCCP), he is also a member of the American Society of Internal Medicine.
