FNPs maintain patient records, perform physical exams, order or perform diagnostic tests, prescribe medications, develop treatment plans, as well as treat acute and chronic illnesses, conditions, and injuries that fall under primary care.

A Board-Certified Adult Nurse Practitioner (ANP-BC) holds board certification and focuses on providing primary health care to adults, although the definition of this broad patient population focus includes patients from age twelve through the senior years. ANPs evaluate, diagnose, and manage common, acute, and chronic health problems among adolescents, adults, and the elderly, and also educate their patients on wellness strategies and disease prevention. They can choose to further specialize in areas of practice ranging from women's health, to cardiovascular or cardiopulmonary care, to mental health care, depending on their experience and the needs of the communities in which they work.
