


Myrna Chavarria, MD, a Neonatologist with Children's Physician Services of South Texas

Neonatologists generally diagnose and treat newborns with conditions such as breathing disorders, infections, and birth defects, as well as coordinating care and medically managing newborns born prematurely, critically ill, or in need of surgery.
