A Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics, the doctor is board-certified in pediatrics and pediatric nephrology by the American Board of Pediatrics (ABP). The mission of the ABP is to advance child health by certifying pediatricians who meet standards of excellence and are committed to continuous learning and improvement.

Licensed to practice medicine in Florida, Pennsylvania, Ohio, and Texas, Dr. Neiberger is affiliated with the Geisinger Medical Center, University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center, UF Health Shands Hospital, University Hospitals MacDonald Women's Hospital, and Rainbow Babies And Children's Hospital. He is also an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Florida College of Medicine.

Pediatrics is the branch of medicine that involves the medical care of infants, children, and adolescents, while nephrology is the subspecialty of internal medicine that focuses on the diagnosis and treatment of diseases of the kidney. Pediatric nephrologists diagnose, treat, and manage many disorders affecting the kidney and urinary tract, including kidney failure, high blood pressure, inherited kidney diseases, kidney stones, urinary tract infections, and abnormalities in the urine such as blood and protein.

As a testament to his excellence, Dr. Neiberger was named Top Doctor in Florida by Castle Connolly in 2000, and in America's Top Doctors by Castle Connolly from 2008 through 2014.
