Subsequent to his education, the doctor attained board certification in anesthesiology and pain medicine through the American Board of Anesthesiology (ABA). As the certifying body for anesthesiologists since 1938, the ABA is committed to partnering with physicians to advance the lifelong learning and exceptional patient care. Its mission is to advance the highest standards of the practice of anesthesiology.

Throughout his line of work, Dr. Marks has presented at national and international meetings including the Texas Pain Society, the International Anesthesia Research Society, the American Society of Anesthesiologists, and the Gulf Atlantic Anesthesia Residency Research Conference.
