Since 2008, Dr. Macleod has served as a Preceptor and Lecturer of the Physician Assistant Program at James Madison University. He is also affiliated with a number of hospitals and medical centers, including Rockingham Memorial Hospital, Shenandoah Memorial Hospital, University of Virginia Medical Center, and Winchester Medical Center.

For half of his career, he practiced medicine in Ontario, Canada before eventually residing and building his practice in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia, which he now calls home.

The majority of his time spent in Virginia has been dedicated to small-town medicine in a solo, independent practice. He has partaken in almost every aspect of medicine that a family physician can experience within his career. This includes, but is not limited to: hospital work (labor and delivery, emergency room, inpatient care, etc.), coroner, community activation activities, statewide health promotion projects, political medical functions, and administrative functions (such as Chief of Staff). Ultimately, all of these experiences have helped him become a better, more well-rounded, and experienced family doctor.

Family medicine is a medical specialty devoted to comprehensive health care for people of all ages. The specialist is called a family physician or family doctor. A family physician is often the first person a patient sees when seeking healthcare services. They examine and treat patients with a wide range of conditions and refer those with serious ailments to a specialist or appropriate facility.
