Pediatrics is the branch of medicine that involves the medical care of infants, children, and adolescents. The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends individuals be under pediatric care up to the age of 21. Pediatricians provide medical care to people ranging in age from newborns to young adults. They are trained to examine, diagnose, and treat children with a wide variety of injuries and illnesses through all of their developmental stages, as they grow and mature.

Neonatal-perinatal medicine is a subspecialty of pediatrics concerned with the care of critically ill newborns and premature infants. Neonatologists diagnose and treat newborns with conditions such as breathing disorders, infections, or birth defects, coordinate care and medically manage newborns born prematurely, critically ill, or in need of surgery, stabilize and treat newborns with any life-threatening medical problems, attend a delivery after which the infant may require medical intervention.

Dr. Sood's professional interests include medicine in underserved areas. Outside her professional commitments, she enjoys dancing hula, watching movies, appreciating animals, spending time with family and friends.
