
## John H. McVicker, MD, FACS, FAANS, a Neurosurgeon with Memorial Hospital at UCHealth

Subsequent to his education, the doctor attained board certification in neurosurgery and neurocritical care through the American Board of Neurological Surgery. The broad aim of the American Board of Neurological Surgery is to encourage the study, improve the practice, elevate the standards, and advance the science of neurological surgery, and thereby serve the cause of public health.

Neurosurgery or neurological surgery, known in common parlance as brain surgery, is the medical specialty concerned with the prevention, diagnosis, surgical treatment, and rehabilitation of disorders that affect any portion of the nervous system including the brain, spinal cord, central and peripheral nervous system, and cerebrovascular system.

Dr. McVicker's research interests cover neurocritical care, neurotrauma, and surgery for movement disorders such as Parkinson's disease and essential tremor. He is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons as well as a Fellow of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons (FAANS). Dr. McVicker is also Vice President of the Western Neurosurgical and a member of the Congress of Neurological Surgeons.
